



LEARN BRIDGE AT THE YOUNG CHELSEA BC

Our next improvers' course starts on Thursday 9th February 2012 and lasts for 8 weeks.

Continuing Bridge

Come and brush up your bridge at one of London's premier playing and teaching venues, the Young Chelsea Bridge Club.

When? Thursday 9th February 2012 at 8.00pm.

Where? The Young Chelsea Bridge Club, 32 Barkston Gardens, Earls Court, SW5 0EN. Barkston Gardens is located approximately 2 minutes from Earls Court tube station. The club is a dedicated Bridge Club with a number of well-appointed playing rooms and a bar that serves drinks and light refreshments.

What? Our *Continuing Bridge* course is suitable for anyone who has attended a first bridge course and who wishes to learn more, or for those who know the basics of the game but would like to improve. In particular, it may suit those who learnt the basics some time ago but feel that their bridge knowledge is very rusty. The first half of the course revises the basic structure of bidding whilst concentrating on play techniques for both declarer and defenders, then we go on to cover further aspects of bidding including openings at the two and three level, competitive bidding and slam bidding. The system used is Acol (the *Standard English* version used by the English Bridge Union as a basis for all its teaching).

How long? The course lasts 8 weeks. All students will be provided with professionally produced notes and be given introductory membership of both the Young Chelsea BC and the English Bridge Union, making you part of the large family of Bridge players across the country. You will also be entitled to 2 free supervised play sessions after the end of the course.

Who will I be taught by? All our tutors are very experienced players and fully qualified EBU-trained teachers.

How much? The course fee, including tuition and all the above benefits, is £145 (or £125 for those who are already members of the Young Chelsea BC).
